Driving perfection

We travel to South Korea (Seoul), Morocco (Marrakech), Portugal (Lisbon) and Mexico (Los Cabos) in search of sumptuous hotels and sublime golf close to the city

SEOUL

South Korea is on the internationa golf map and its women are leading the charge. Korean-born New Zealander Lydia Ko was World Number One for 85 weeks, Inbee Park won Olympic gold at Rio 2016 and Sung Hyun Park has recently taken the prestigious US Women's Open.

Seoul hosted the 1988
Olympic Games before golf was back on the roster, but there is no shortage of phenomenal options around the Special
Metropolitan City

Gapyeong Benest Golf Club, host of the 39th Korean Ladies PGA Championship in September, is a trademark Jack Nicklaus-designed course with wide fairways and well protected, undulating greens.

Its 27 holes are configured as three returning nines with Maple and Pine combining to form the premier 18. The signature hole, however, is the downhill par-4 third on the Birch course.

Gapyeong Benest Golf Club is one of five Korean golf centres owned by Samsung

MARRAKECH

Last November, The illustrious World Golf Awards bestowed the honour of 'Africa's Best Golf Course 2016' upon Assoufic Golf Course, a luxury 18-hole course designed that winds its way through undulating desert landscape against a dramatic backdrop of the snow-capped Atlas Mountains.

Scottish designer and former

European Tour player, Niall Cameron, has designed the majority of holes in a north-south orientation to maximise impact of the spellbinding views and elevated tees where possible.

The par-3 17th is the club's signature hole with a panoramic drive from the highest point on the oolf course.

The club recognises the importance of protecting and enhancing its natural environment, in which only 45% of the golf course was planted to minimise water consumption.

Located 10 kilometres from Marrakech's Medina – a UNESCO World Heritage site – the Assoufic Course is easily reached from the Port du Golf Royal Mandarin Oriental. Lying in 20 hectares of

The most westerly tip of Europe offers one of the world's most stunning golf courses. Oitavos Dunes plays on the stark contrast between the Sintra Mountains and the Atlantic Ocean. It is only one of two courses designed by the famous Michigan-born Arthur Hills on the continent, but is by no means a stereotypical American target golf track. Measuring slightly over 6,300m, the course is a wonderful blend of woodland and links golf with firm, fast and undulating greens. The 14th is a spectacular dune-lined par-3 over a storm ravine that can play far longer than its 153m suggests.

The resort of Quinta da Marinha is located 35 kilometres west of Lisbon in the stunning Sintra-Cascais National Park, close to the classic seaside towns of Estoril and Cascais. The Four Seasons Ritz Hotel is located right in the heart of Lisbon. but has excellent access to the of the historic city, overlooking Eduardo VII Park, St. George's

Atlantic coast. Its private terraces provide a splendid birds-eye view

While the accommodations at Diamante are world-class. it is 15 kilometres west of Los Cabos. For those who want to stay closer to the action, Hacienda Beach Club and Residences are set along a private stretch of Medano Beach. With views of the breathtaking Land's End formation, the resort grants direct access to the beach, plus a world of shopping, dining, sightseeing, and nightlife on the Baja coast.
