# Super charter

Chartering private Superyachts is a practical and affordable way to travel in style without financial or logistical anchors — and a chance to try before you buy

achting is one stream of luxury living that seems inexorably exciting and often unattainable to many. Thankfully, there are charter options for those who don't own their own yachts or don't expect they would use one enough to justify the purchase.

### O'REA

O'rea is a full 77.7m in length and is capable of hosting 12 guests in 8 cabins, with a 22-person crew. The cruising speed reaches 16.5 knots, and the boat was built by Golden Yachts for the New Generation series, just recently finished in 2023. A week of

onboard adventure starts from around US\$580,000.

The owner's suite onboard had an adjoining private office, and the full-width glass doors blend the interior and exterior seamlessly. The main deck has a saloon with a bar and dining area and floor to ceiling windows, while the upper deck has a lounge with a piano, a gorgeous chandeller and a full audio visual system for movie nights or dance parties.

Two glass-bottomed pools, one on the main deck and one on the sun deck, let in light to the lower decks, and are complemented by a beach club with on-deck jacuzzi

where you can soak up the sun and scenery. A Turkish hammam, massage and beauty room and state-of-the-art gym complete the luxurious wellness facilities. atalantagoldenyachts.com

### AIX

The yacht AIX, which can be chartered through Ocean Alliance, finished construction in 2022. It is 44.5m, or 146ft, long and offers accommodation for 10 guests to sleep, but is available for day charters for up to 12 guests.

The yacht is based around a San Lorenzo naval build and has five cabins, with the exterior

and interiors all designed by the Zuccan International Project.

The owner's cabin alone is an incredible 147 square metres across three decks, including direct access to the foredeck pool. The onboard beach club is 100 square metres and the yacht also offers a jet ski, sea bobs and equipment for scuba excursions, fenders, paddle boards and a jacuzzi.

The yacht's speed tops out at 23 knots, but cruises around 11. The vessel is available to charter in Australia and the South Pacific, and each 24 hours on board costs around US\$45,600, with a booking minimum of three nights, or an entire week can be booked for US\$255,000. oceanalliance.com/yachts/aix

## **WANDERLUST**

Wanderlust, completed in 2022 by Silveryachts, is a sports activity vessel, or an SAV, and is kitted out with everything needed for an adventure at sea. With three tenders, sea-doos, seabobs, dinghies, kayaks and paddle boards, as well as all the equipment needed to scuba dive and snorkel, it's the perfect vessel for onboard activities.

The yacht is an impressive 85.3m (279.8ft) and can accommodate 12 guests in 8 cabins and cruises at a speed of 17 knots, topping out at 23. The owner's suite has direct access to a deck and The Loft is a gorgeous winter garden space with floor-to-ceiling privacy glass that can convert into an open air terrace.

The sun deck on board also has a glass-fronted jacuzzi and the aft deck is 400 square metres, a full 30m long. There are three

onboard cinema screens and ceiling screens for entertainment purposes. The upper deck has a dining area with a bar and BBQ options, as well as a sun lounge, and the open air dining space on the main deck is also kitted out for quests.

The yacht can be chartered for around US\$960,000 a week and tours through the Indian Ocean and the South Pacific. burgessyachts.com

# **COME TOGETHER**

This new Amels superyacht, finished in 2022, is one of just 60 new limited-edition boats, and has been designed by the one and only Espen Øino. It's 60m in total and can house 12 guests in 6 cabins, with an onboard crew of 14. The yacht cruises at 15.5 knots and

costs around US\$450,000 per week to charter. In the summer, the yacht cruises through the west and east Mediterranean, and in the winter it visits the Caribbean and the Bahamas.

The vessel boasts a 38 square metre swim platform to launch the onboard tenders and seabobs, in addition to a 27m sun deck with loungers, a jacuzzi and a bar with a dining table. There is also an onboard open-air cinema and decks for partying, and all the interiors were designed by London-based Winch Design.

The owner's suite has full height windows and a balcony that, when the yacht is anchored, can fold out to a sizable terrace.

There is also a helicopter landing pad for easy access. *y.co/yacht/come-together*
