Sleep among the stars in some of the tallest penthouses in the most iconic cities around the world

HERON TOWER, LONDON

Soaring 36 stories above London, The Heron is located near the Barbican and Moorgate and

offers sweeping views of the city skyline, with a coveted address in the capital's cultural and financial hub. Designed by David Walker Architects and RHWL Architects, the structure emphasizes energy efficiency, with innovative features like rainwater harvesting and energy-efficient heating.

The South Penthouse spans over 6,000 square feet across two floors, featuring floor-to-ceiling windows that frame St. Paul's Cathedral and The London Eye. Inside, the residence boasts luxurious finishes, including Sahara Noir marble floors, Boffi kitchen, and expansive living areas for entertaining.

The North Penthouse, covering around 4,000 square feet, offers double-height ceilings and retractable roofs.

Residents enjoy amenities that include a private club lounge, screening room, gym, and a landscaped rooftop garden. Concierge services, valet parking, and a private bar elevate the living experience to one of luxury and comfort. TOUR ODEON TOWER, MONACO

170 meters above sea level, the Sky Penthouse at Tour Odeon offers unparalleled 360-degree views of Monaco. Valued at US\$270m, it spans over 3,300 square meters and occupies the top five floors of the building. This penthouse features five bedrooms, seven bathrooms, private pools, cinema room, spa, and floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking a terrace with a round swimming pool and waterslide.

Located in the serene La Rousse/Saint Roman district, it's just a short walk to Larvotto Beach, blending privacy with Monaco's vibrant lifestyle. Designed by architect Renzo Piano and developed by the Odeon Group, the building combines natural materials with

MARINA 101 PENTHOUSE, DUBAI

Perched atop the tallest residential building in the UAE, the Marina 101 Penthouse is the epitome of grandeur. Designed by Khatib & Alami, this penthouse includes six bedrooms and seven bathrooms, with living areas finished in marble, polished wood, and unique furnishings. A private

CENTRAL PARK TOWER, NEW YORK

At 1,550 feet, Central Park Tower is the tallest residential building in the Western Hemisphere. The triplex penthouse, spanning 17,545 square feet across three floors, offers panoramic views of Central Park, the Hudson River, and the Manhattan skyline. With seven bedrooms and eight bathrooms, this residence boasts ceilings up to 27 feet.

Designed by Adrian Smith and Gordon Gill Architecture, the building also houses a seven-story Nordstrom flagship store. The penthouse includes private elevators, a private park, a 60-foot outdoor pool, and a fitness centre. Residents also have access to the Central Park Club, which features a Grand Ballroom, a private restaurant with panoramic views, and an exclusive wine cellar.
